

U.S. Senator Rob Portman was elected to the U.S. Senate in 2010. He represents Ohio with what he calls, “common sense conservative ideas to help create jobs and get the deficit under control.” Before joining the Senate, he was the Director of the Office of Management and Budget under President George Bush, where he advocated a balanced budget. Portman also served as a U.S. Trade Representative and a U.S. Congressman. Portman was born and raised in Cincinnati.

- \$190 million in infrastructure investments


- Over 200 new member organizations

- Digital media presence grew by over 20%




- Advocated for the passage of HB5: Municipal Tax Reform
